Bimbo Bakeries Donates \$7,000 for Pool Repairs

Bimbo Bakeries, located in Placentia, donated \$7,000 to the City for much needed pool repairs at the Whitten Community Center and Gomez Community Center, through their Good Neighbor Program. The program has been launched at over seventy (70) Bimbo Bakery plants to provide resources to make improvements to community facilities to promote physical fitness. The City submitted a few unfunded improvement projects previously identified by the Recreation and Parks Commission and the Capital Improvement Program (CIP). Bimbo Bakeries contacted the City in June about the grant award and chose to make repairs to the filtration and pump systems to ensure that each pool can meet all health department standards of operation to support the Recreation Swim Program. The Recreation Swim Program is a free program that provides children and adults the opportunity to cool off on hot summer days and enjoy recreational experiences. It also serves as a place for children to become comfortable in the water and practice swimming techniques learned in formal swim classes or informally by parents or guardians. An average of 2,650 participants attend Recreation Swim annually. The City of Placentia truly appreciates Bimbo Bakeries contributions to our community.

Back to School Safety

Fall is in the air and children will soon be returning to the classroom. Here are some reminders from the Police Department to help keep the children of Placentia safe. Remember your child's safety is our number one priority.

Drivers:

- Be aware when school starts and ends. Plan extra time during those peak hours to avoid traffic issues and frustration.
- Drive carefully and reduce speeds in residential neighborhoods, bus stops, and school zones.
- Be aware of your child's school drop off and pick up procedures. This will help alleviate traffic congestion and frustration.
- Remember if a school bus' red lights are flashing you must stop! No passing the school bus in either direction when the flashing red lights are activated.

Bus Riders:

- Remind children to never wait for the school bus in the street.
- Always stand 2 feet away from the curb.

Walkers:

- Always walk on the sidewalk to and from school. If there is no sidewalk, walk facing traffic.
- Never dart out in front of parked cars.
- When crossing the street, look both ways for cars.

Notify Me and Crime Alerts

Want to receive Crime Alerts from the Police Department? The Placentia Police Department recently added a new preference on the City website's Notify Me. By adding "Police" to your notifications through Notify Me, you will be able to receive email and text message updates from the Police Department on Special Events, Police News, Updates to the Law, and of course Crime Alerts.

Notify Me is the City's opt-in way for citizens to receive pushed notifications regarding different City topics. The City also offers preferences on different notifications including Community Services, Field Conditions, Placentia Quarterly, and City Council Agendas to name just a few.




