City Council Adopts Balanced Operating Budget

The City’s budget is an important policy document. It serves as an annual financial plan, identifying the spending priorities for the organization. The budget is used to balance available resources with community needs, as determined by the City Council. It also serves as a tool for communicating the City’s financial strategies and for ensuring accountability.

The City’s operating budget is a plan for one specified fiscal year. The fiscal year for this budget begins on July 1, 2014 and ends on June 30, 2015. The proposed Fiscal Year (FY) 2014–15 budget is the culmination of many months of work by City Staff with direction and input from the City Council and community.

The FY 2014–15 General Fund budget includes \$29,802,252 in expenditures. Personnel costs, which include salaries and benefits, represent 48.2% of the total expenditures. Operational costs, which include materials, services and supplies, account for \$11,506,774 or 38.6% of the budget. Capital Outlay and Debt Service costs total \$1,082,512. Overall expenditures have decreased by 5% from FY 2013–14 as a result of several cost cutting measures.

Taxes provide the majority of the revenues the City uses to cover the cost of public services. Property, sales and transient occupancy taxes comprise 62.8%, or \$18.7 million of the \$29,802,300 million in revenues used to fund expenditures. Licenses, permits and franchise fees represent 12.8% (\$3.8 million) of revenues. Interfund transfers from other funds make up another 14.7% (\$4.4 million) with the remaining, 9.7% (\$2.9 million) coming from fines, interest, rent and other miscellaneous sources.

Like so many other cities across the country, Placentia has a structural imbalance where the cost of public services exceeds the amount of annual revenues creating an annual budget deficit. This year the City’s budget deficit was projected to reach \$1.7 million. Fortunately, City Staff, through a combination of cost saving measures, staff reductions and slightly better revenue estimates, was able to present a balanced budget to the City Council. Unfortunately, more work lies ahead to address the fundamental structural imbalance that continues to prevent the City from achieving fiscal sustainability. Based on initial estimates, expenditures will continue to exceed available revenues each year and the deficit is projected to grow to nearly \$5 Million by FY 2017–18.

General Municipal Election – November 4, 2014

The City of Placentia consolidates its regular elections with statewide elections held on the first Tuesday in November of even-numbered years. The next General Municipal Election for the City of Placentia will take place on November 4, 2014 for the purpose of filling two seats on the City Council and one City Clerk position, each for a full term of four years.

To register to vote you must be a United States citizen, at least 18 years of age on or before the date of the next election, and not in prison or on parole for a felony conviction.

To vote in an election you must register to vote at least 15 days prior to the election date. You may pick up a Voter Registration Form in person at City Hall, public libraries, city and county offices, California Department of Motor Vehicles offices, and at U.S. Post offices. Mailing instructions are located on the form. Voter registration forms are also available on the Secretary of State website at www.sos.ca.gov and the Orange County Registrar of Voters website at www.ocvote.com. Voter registrations are filed by county; make sure to re-register every time you move, change your name, or change your political party choice.






