## General Plan Update

The City of Placentia is updating its General Plan, a key planning document that will shape the future of your community by providing direction for growth and change in Placentia. The General Plan will include goals, policies and implementation actions addressing important community needs ranging from land use and mobility, to public safety. Some of the newer General Plan elements include economic development, sustainability and health and wellness.

Every city in California has a General Plan; however the City's current General Plan is outdated. The updated General Plan will comprehensively revisit the community's priorities and establish a vision for the next 25 years. The General Plan will include goals, policies, and implementation actions addressing several topics. Some of these topics are required by state law and others will be included based upon input from the community.

The City will be hosting two community meeting workshops to discuss the elements of the General Plan update. These workshops will take place at the Placentia Library Community Room at 411 E. Chapman Avenue on the following dates:

- Wednesday November 19, 2014 (6pm-8pm)
- Wednesday February 25, 2015 (6pm-8pm)

## Christmas Tree Recycling

Every year, more than 40,000 tons of Christmas trees require handling at the end of the season in California. You can help divert waste from the landfill by following these simple steps:

1. Remove the tree stand (wood or metal), decorations and tinsel from your tree.
2. Cut up your tree and place in your brown container (no tree stands please). The pieces should fit easily in your container.
3. Place the brown container at the curb along with the other containers on your regular collection day.

If you're unable to put your tree in your brown yard waste can, place the tree at the curb next to your containers on your regular collection day from Monday, December 29, 2014 until Friday, January 9, 2015. Trees are collected in a special truck. Trees larger than six feet tall must be cut in half.

## OCTA's Grade Separation Projects Update

- Orangethorpe Avenue is closed between Chapman Avenue and Crowther Avenue/Miller Street, with access currently provided to Rose Drive. Chapman Avenue is expected to be closed at Orangethorpe Avenue in January, 2015.
- On Lakeview Avenue, preliminary construction activities related to utilities is currently taking place. Lakeview Avenue is expected to close in April, 2015. A temporary traffic signal at Richfield Avenue & Miraloma Avenue and a permanent traffic signal at Richfield Avenue & Orchard Drive, both under construction, will assist traffic through the detour.
