To encourage all views, Council and Agency Board discourage clapping, booing or shouts of approval or disagreement from the audience.

CC 1. **Consideration of Resolutions to add a ballot measure to the November 2, 2010 General Municipal Election and authorize the priority and deadline for the submission of written arguments**

Financial Impact: \$8,500 (estimated additional cost); \$54,500 was appropriated for the General Municipal Election in the Fiscal Year 2010/2011 Budget (Account No. 101002-6299) and it is estimated that this amount will cover the cost for the election of officers and the ballot measure.

Recommended Action: It is recommended that the City Council:

1. Adopt the appropriate Resolutions adding a ballot measure to the Tuesday, November 2, 2010 General Municipal Election, setting priorities for filing written arguments regarding a City measure, and directing the City Attorney to prepare an impartial analysis.
2. Receive and file the Notice to voters of date after which no arguments for or against a City measure may be submitted to the City Clerk (Friday, August 6, 2010, 5:00 p.m.).
