## General Plan Update

The City of Placentia is updating its General Plan, a key planning document that will shape the future of your community by providing direction for growth and change in Placentia. The General Plan will include goals, policies and implementation actions addressing important community needs ranging from land use and mobility, to public safety. Some of the newer General Plan elements include economic development, sustainability and health and wellness.

Every City in California has a General Plan; however the City's current General Plan is outdated. The updated General Plan will comprehensively revisit the community's priorities and establish a vision for the next 25 years. The General Plan will include goals, policies, and implementation actions addressing several topics. Some of these topics are required by state law and others will be included based upon input from the community.

On Wednesday, November 19, 2014 the City hosted the first of two community meeting workshops to discuss the elements of the General Plan update. The second community workshop will take place at the Backs Community Building located at 201 N. Bradford Avenue on Wednesday February 25, 2015 from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM.

## Citizens Fiscal Sustainability Task Force

The City has implemented a number of cost reduction and revenue enhancement measures over the past few years to address the City's financial challenges. Despite these measures, the City continues to operate with an annual structural deficit. The City's five year fiscal forecast projects that this deficit will grow each year. To assist the City in identifying long-term solutions toward fiscal stability, the City Council is appointing a Citizens Fiscal Sustainability Task Force.

The Task Force will be comprised of seven at-large members, being sought through an application process. This seven-member Task Force will examine the City's structural deficit and assist the City in identifying potential cost reduction and revenue enhancement solutions.
