FREE USED OIL RECYCLING

Placentia residents are eligible for FREE recycling of their used engine, transmission and gear oil, plastic motor oil bottles, oil filters and oily rags from their homes. The household collection program is FREE via a grant from Cal Recycle. To schedule a pick up or for more information, please call 1-800-HHW-PKUP (1-800-449-7587) or visit www.placentia.org.

FREE BULKY ITEM PICK-UP SERVICE

Republic Services offers residents 3 FREE curbside bulky item collection per year. They will remove old appliances and furniture at no cost to you! Don't put off a major cleaning project any longer!

FREE SHARPS CONTAINERS

Have any needles, syringes, scalpels or other sharps? Dispose of them safely and cleanly with a free sharps container from the City of Placentia. You may pick up your free sharps container at City Hall, located at 401 East Chapman Avenue. You may then take your filled sharps container to the Household Hazardous Waste Collection Center located at 1071 North Blue Gum in Anaheim, CA 92806. Call (714) 834-6752 for more information.

WITH THANKSGIVING APPROACHING, CONSIDER THIS

Many of us have purchased turkey fryers. These can produce a moist, delicious bird for our Thanksgiving dinners. They also produce a significant amount of cooking grease, which can cause serious blockages in sewer lines and leak from the bottom of trash containers.

Please collect the waste grease from your turkey fryer and dispose of it at your local Household Hazardous Waste Center. Call (714) 834-4000 for locations and hours of operation.

CHRISTMAS TREE RECYCLING

Every year, more than 40,000 tons of Christmas trees require handling at the end of the season in California. You can help divert waste from the landfill by following these simple steps:

1. Remove the tree stand (wood or metal), decorations and tinsel from your tree.
2. Cut up your tree and place in your brown container (no tree stands please). The pieces should fit easily in your container.
3. Place the brown container at the curb along with the other containers on your regular collection day.

If you are unable to put your tree in your brown yard waste can, place the tree at the curb next to your containers on your regular collection day from Wednesday, December 27, 2017 until Friday, January 5, 2018. Trees are collected in a special truck. Trees larger than six feet tall must be cut in half.

OLD TOWN PLACENTIA REVITALIZATION PLAN APPROVED BY CITY COUNCIL

The City of Placentia has been given a unique opportunity with the new state-of-the-art Metrolink Station and 253-space parking structure within the Old Town Placentia area. Operational by 2020, the proposed Station can help transform the Old Town District (centered around Bradford Avenue and Santa Fe Avenue) into an active, vibrant destination. Among Orange County's downtowns, Old Town Placentia is unique in its small scale and variety of land uses. Today, population groups of all types are looking for small scale, walkable urban centers around transit to live, work, and play. This is occurring in Orange County with new, more compact, and transit-oriented developments and historic reuse districts emerging in Anaheim, Orange, Fullerton, and Santa Ana.



To facilitate the transformation, the City of Placentia has approved a Revitalization Plan, an amendment to the General Plan and Zoning Code along with adopting a Streetscape Master Plan to augment the historic character

of Placentia's Old Town. The Old Town already features a diverse mix of land uses, and the Revitalization Plan will complement and allow for additional growth in the Old Town District, resulting in a pedestrian oriented retail district centered on the historic core with mixed use and residential planning areas surrounding the historic core, creating new development opportunities for a one-of-a-kind destination. The plan will support existing retail and restaurant businesses in the Old Town District and in the nearby Transit-Oriented Development (TOD) District, and will benefit the citywide and regional economy.

To take advantage of the upcoming Metrolink Station and Parking Structure, scheduled to begin construction in 2018, the Old Town Placentia Revitalization Plan builds on the core strength of this asset, our community and visitors to the area. Thus, the goal of the Old Town Revitalization Plan is to create a vibrant, safe and pedestrian friendly area that respects the community's historical and cultural diversity. This comprehensive Plan will incorporate well-designed private and public physical improvements and amenities.

The Old Town District and Revitalization Plan will generate public and private investments of up to \$217 million in the District and the City. Upon completion, the Old Town project area (pictured) is estimated to generate approximately \$926,000 in annual General Fund revenue for the City. Additionally, the proposed Old Town Revitalization Plan would assist with reconstructing streets and providing enhanced street improvements. In total, revitalization of the Old Town District is estimated to generate approximately 1,880 jobs, which will aid in improving Placentia's local economy. Products such as plants, cleaners, oils, batteries, and pesticides that contain potentially hazardous ingredients require special care when you dispose of them. Orange County residents can dispose of their Household Hazardous Waste items for FREE at any of the County's four Household Hazardous Waste Collection Centers. DID YOU KNOW...

• **GARAGE SALES** may be conducted on the first full weekend of the months of March, June, September and December on Saturday and Sunday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. without the need for a permit. Two additional garage sale permits within a calendar year may be requested by filling out a Garage Sale Permit to be approved by Code Enforcement in the Police Department during business hours. There is no charge for this permit. For additional information, please refer to Municipal Code 23.81.030 Garage Sales or call (714) 993-8164.

• **STOP BLOCKING THE SEWER**
Dispose of eggshells, coffee grounds, and cat litter in the trash as these items can cause serious sewer blockages. Dispose of fats, cooking oils, and grease in the trash also. Use plenty of flush water when using the garbage disposal. It is important to periodically have your service laterals (the privately owned sewer line between your house to the connection with the City collector line under the street) cleaned out. Root intrusion and grease blockages are the largest causes of blockages.






