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

COMMUNITY OUTREACH UPDATE ON OUR FISCAL SUSTAINABILITY

The City will be continuing to update you on the status of our efforts to achieve long-term fiscal sustainability for our City while protecting the quality of life services our residents and those doing business in the City expect and deserve.

Thank you to the hundreds of residents who have participated to date through these meetings and through our online survey. We were gratified to hear that the community values the work that we do and the services our City provides. Moving forward, we are eager to continue our public outreach on service priorities as the City continues to go through its 2018-2019 budget process.

As our community is aware, depleted local revenues, historical State takeaways, and reduced City funds due to an increase in online purchases have left Placentia with a \$6.1 million structural deficit. Because of this, certain basic City services and maintenance continue to be deferred. Over \$3.2 million a year for the past 7 years in street and road maintenance have been deferred.

In response to community feedback prioritizing public safety, Placentia currently maintains a proactive Police presence in our neighborhoods, parks and schools, with anti-drug and anti-gang police officers, youth violence prevention and gang-related graffiti programs to help keep our kids off the streets and out of trouble. With our current structural deficit, these services may be reduced in the years to come, impacting our quality of life and our property values.

The City will continue to engage our residents about our fiscal challenges and solicit input on your service priorities and recommendations for creating new revenues and/or reducing costs. 

CITY LAUNCHES

iPLACENTIA MOBILE APP

The City of Placentia is pleased to announce the launch of its new mobile app, iPlacentia, as part of an ongoing effort to improve communication and make city government more accessible to its residents. The iPlacentia mobile app is a smartphone application that allows users to instantly submit service requests for issues such as potholes, graffiti, and street light outages with just the touch of a button. The report is then automatically sent to the respective department for review. The iPlacentia app also features direct access to recent city news, upcoming events and meetings, permit applications and job openings.

"We're always looking for new ways to increase civic engagement with the members of our community," said Placentia Mayor Chad Wanke. "With so many of us using our smart phones and tablets everywhere we go, we are excited to offer this free, mobile-friendly tool, for residents to both stay informed of City happenings, as well as report non-emergency issues."

iPlacentia uses GPS technology to automatically provide the problem's exact location, simplifying the reporting process for users while increasing the reliability of report location for city crews. The user submitting the service request is instantly notified when the City receives it and also when it has been resolved. iPlacentia also allows residents to track the status of their request, register for recreational classes and activities, renew a business license, contact City Council or Staff directly, and more!

"We are excited to deliver this tool to our community in addressing their concerns," said City Administrator Damien R. Arrula. "Our goal is to continually improve customer service for our residents and businesses and this app helps us achieve that goal. iPlacentia will allow the City to quickly address any area of concern more efficiently and improve our City services."

iPlacentia is available for free download on all iPhone and Android devices. Simply search "iPlacentia" on the App Store or GooglePlay. Residents without internet access can report service requests by phone at (714) 993-8131. For troubleshooting with the app, please call (714) 993-8171. The iPlacentia App is not intended for use in reporting emergency situations or crimes in progress. If you have an emergency, please dial 9-1-1.





PUMP UP PLACENTIA

The City of Placentia is pleased to announce it has entered into a unique partnership with Galaxy Oil Company to operate the “Placentia Gas Station,” also known as Best 4 Less 76 gasoline station at 480 S. Placentia Avenue. Through the partnership, a portion of the revenue generated by the gas station will go directly back to the City, providing an incentive for residents and visitors to “Pump Up Placentia” by putting money directly back into the local economy.

The City’s agreement with Galaxy Oil is for a period of 10 years. The Placentia Gas Station is estimated to generate \$25,000 in base annual rent for the City and up to \$350,000 in annual General Fund Revenue.

“This is a chance for customers to fill-up at a gas station where a big chunk of their dollars spent will go directly back into City coffers to fund our local services and programs,” said Placentia Mayor Chad Wanke. “The major aim here is to not only deliver quality gas at a low price but also offer customers a compelling reason to fill-up and support their City.”

The location of the Placentia Gas Station, 480 S. Placentia Avenue, is a City-owned property on the corner of W. Crowther Avenue and S. Placentia Avenue. Though there are many gas stations in the region, City Administrator Damien R. Arrula says residents can now choose a station where they know a portion of every dollar spent goes back to City programs, infrastructure, and services.

“Almost everybody needs gas on a regular basis,” Arrula said. “We want residents to know they have a choice to fill up at a place where some of that money spent is being directly returned back into their community. Every time they fill up it helps us with critical services such as police and fire.”

Effective with the agreement, fill-ups on all City vehicles that cannot occur at the City Yard pumps will now occur at the Placentia Gas Station. LEARN-TO-SWIM PROGRAM

The City of Placentia Learn-to-Swim Program offers swimming instruction for youth ages nine months through twelve years. All Water Safety Instructors are trained and certified by the American Red Cross. The program is offered at Valencia High School in the morning and afternoon and at El Dorado High School for evening classes.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Learn-to-Swim Program registration begins at the Summer Recreation Program Kick-off event on Saturday, June 2, at Placentia City Hall and is not available online. Only Placentia residents will be permitted to register on this day. A parent or legal guardian must be present to register a child. Proof of residency (i.e. driver's license, state issued ID card, or recent utility bill) must be provided to be eligible to register. Registration numbers will be handed out on a first-come, first-serve basis beginning at 7:00 a.m. Registration will begin at 9:00 a.m. and continues until 12:00 p.m. Proof of age is required at the time of registration for new program participants (birth certificate).

PUBLIC RECREATION SWIM

The City of Placentia offers free recreation swim at the Gomez Community Pool and at the Whitten Community Pool. Children seven years and under must be accompanied by an adult in a swimsuit and must be within arm's reach at all times. Flotation devices are NOT allowed during recreation swim.

REFUND REQUESTS:

Refund requests for Learn-to-Swim classes must be made 7 days prior to the start of the session. A \$5 administration fee applies per class. Refund requests received less than 7 days prior to the start of the session will be processed at 50% of the registration fees. Refunds are not available once the session begins. There are no make-ups for missed classes or partial refunds.

We reserve the right to move your child from the class that you signed up for to one that is more developmentally appropriate.

SWIM LESSON DESCRIPTIONS

Big Fish, Lil' Fish

9 months to 3 years

A basic water orientation class for tots and their parents. The child and parent work on skills together in the water. Skills include water adjustment, blowing bubbles, kicking, holding onto the wall, floating on back, water entry and exit, face submergence, and safety skills. A parent is required to accompany each child.

Tiny Tots

3 to 5 years

A class for preschoolers who have very little to no aquatic experience. Fun and safety are emphasized while learning necessary swimming skills such as water entry and exit, face submergence, blowing bubbles, water adjustment, kicking, exploring arm movements, and safety skills.

Level 1

5 to 12 years

A class for children who have very little to no aquatic experience. Fun and safety are emphasized while learning necessary swimming skills: water entry and exit, face submergence, water adjustment, floating on front and back, retrieval of submerged objects, and safety skills. In this class children will learn how to side breathe as well as practice freestyle and backstroke.

Level 2

5 to 12 years

Class reviews entry by stepping or jumping from side, bobbing, head submergence and holding breath, floating on front and back, treading water, side breathing, freestyle, backstroke, and safety skills. Participants will also be introduced to elementary backstroke.

Prerequisite - Participant must be able to demonstrate the following with little to no assistance: safely enter and exit the water, float on front and back without support, swim freestyle the entire length of the pool.

Level 3

5 to 12 years

In this class, children will review side breathing techniques, freestyle, backstroke, and elementary backstroke. They will also be introduced to breaststroke and kneeling and standing dives. Participants will continue to practice treading water, retrieving submerged objects, and safety skills.

Prerequisite - Participants should be very comfortable in the water and able to swim a least one lap (25 yards) without any assistance.

Level 4

5 to 12 years

Class will continue to practice treading water, retrieving submerged objects, kneeling and standing dives, and safety skills. Along with perfecting freestyle, backstroke, and breaststroke, they will be introduced to butterfly.

Prerequisite - Participants should be very confident freestyle swimmers and comfortable with backstroke and breaststroke.

Level 5

5 to 12 years

The course will focus on reviewing all of the strokes, underwater swimming dives, flip turns, and safety skills including survival swimming and rescue breathing.

Prerequisite - Swimmers should be comfortable with all swimming strokes and able to swim constantly throughout the 30 minute class.


