DOWNLOAD THE iPLACENTIA MOBILE APP TODAY

The City of Placentia's mobile app iPlacentia makes it easier than ever to report issues within City limits and make local City government accessible to its residents. iPlacentia allows users to instantly submit service requests for issues such as potholes, graffiti, street light outages, trash, and so much more. The app uses GPS technology to provide the problem's exact location and it is automatically submitted to the responsible department for review. The requester will be notified when the issue has been received and resolved.

Additional features of the mobile app allow residents to read about the latest City news and events, register for recreational classes and activities, renew a business license, access permit applications, view job openings, contact City Council or Staff, and more!

iPlacentia is available for free download on all iPhone and Android devices. Simply search "iPlacentia" in the App Store or GooglePlay. Residents without internet access can report service requests by phone at (714) 993-8131. For troubleshooting with the app, please call (714) 993-8171. The iPlacentia App is not intended for use in reporting emergency situations or crimes in progress. If you have an emergency, please dial 9-1-1.

DID YOU KNOW.....

BULKY-ITEM & E-WASTE COLLECTION PROGRAM

Help Keep our neighborhood, streets, and alleys free of unwanted furniture, appliances, and other bulky items by using Republic Services for bulky item pick-up. If an item won't fit in your trash container, contact Republic Services. All single-family residential customers are entitled to three (3) free bulky item pick-ups per year. Additional pickups are available for a fee. Bulky item pick-ups for multi-family dwelling, properties with five (5) units or more, and businesses come at a cost. Bulky items include, but are not limited to, furniture, water heaters, large appliances, electronic waste and other bulky items. There is a disposal fee for items containing CFC's Freon. For more information and/or to schedule a bulky item pick-up, please call Republic Services at (714) 238-2444.

If you are doing a large clean-out or remodeling your home, call Republic Services at (714) 238-2444 to learn more about renting a larger waste container. These can be delivered to your driveway and picked up when you have filled them.

Remember that household hazardous waste is NOT picked up at the curb. If you have unneeded household chemicals, such as tub and tile cleaner, toilet bowl cleaner, paint, stain, paint thinner, used motor oil, antifreeze, pool chemicals, pesticides, and similar hazardous products, you may dispose of them for FREE at the Orange County Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Collection Centers, which are open Tuesday through Saturday, from 9:00 AM - 3:00 PM (closed major holidays and during rainy weather). Placentia residents are eligible for FREE recycling of their used engine, transmission and gear oil, plastic motor oil bottles, oil filters and oily rags from their homes. FIRE PROTECTION & EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES UPDATE

In our continued effort to maintain and enhance rapid emergency response times and ensure a high level of these life-saving services over the long-term for our residents, the City has been undertaking a competitive process to solicit proposals from qualified service providers for fire protection services and emergency medical services.

In early 2019, the City encouraged qualified service providers to submit competitive proposals to ensure the City can maintain and enhance rapid emergency response times well into the future. The proposal period has closed, and an independent Proposal Review Panel comprised of nationally-renowned experts in Fire and Emergency Medical Services, local leaders, community members and City officials will be recommending service providers to the City Council for consideration in June.

We look forward to updating you on the progress of the City's process to examine new and innovative ways to improve high-quality emergency response programs and service models while ensuring the cost to provide those programs are reasonable and sustainable for our community.

THE CITY OF PLACENTIA'S MASS NOTIFICATION SYSTEMS: ALERTOC AND NIXLE

After many deadly wildfires ravaged Northern and Southern California, many people were left wondering, “Why didn’t the city adequately notify the residents of the incoming fire?” Unfortunately, with the change in technology and limits that the government has to send notifications to mobile devices, a significant amount of the population will not receive Emergency Alerts in the event that a local emergency has occurred or is approaching. To mitigate this problem many cities within the State of California and Orange County have implemented alternative emergency alert platforms to notify the general public in ways that are more in-line with the type of technology that exists and innovative platforms that are adaptive to the mobile lifestyles that many people have on a daily basis.

The City of Placentia actively uses two mass notification and emergency alert platforms, Nixle and AlertOC. Both AlertOC and Nixle allow for emergency alerts to be sent to your mobile device(s) and e-mail(s) if there are incidents going on within the city that are deemed important enough to warrant public notification. The primary benefit of the system is immediate, straight-from-the-source information that informs the public of various incidents.

Although the systems are similar, the City has elected to use the platforms in two distinct ways to allow for people to decide which platform works the best for their interest. The benefit of these systems can be seen in three critical ways when reaching out to members of the community. First, as our communities discontinue the use of landlines and traditional television within their homes, the City no longer has the capacity to reach people in the traditional ways that we have in previous years; the AlertOC and Nixle systems fill those gaps and provide similar or greater access to emergency alerts in the City.

Next, the use of the AlertOC and Nixle systems allows the City to provide rapid and specific information to the members of a specific community without delay. Previously, the City would have to reach out to the County or private partners to organize a message and have it sent out to homes only; the two systems provide the City with the capacity to send out emergency and advisory alerts to the community in an expedited manner and reduce the likelihood that a message may be changed during transmission.

Finally, the AlertOC and Nixle platforms allow subscribed members of the community to receive notifications while they are at work, traveling, and messages that are critical to family members (e.g. children’s school, parent’s home). The systems’ ability to reach people away from the City is critical because we want to make sure that we are providing the best information to members of our community, even if they are not within the city.

The AlertOC platform is used only in the event of widespread emergencies that require immediate action by members of the community. Alerts that will come from the AlertOC will also be sent to homes that have a dedicated landline via reverse 9-1-1 data, but the alerts will not connect to individual mobile devices that have not opt-ed into the AlertOC system. To opt into the AlertOC system, send a text message to 888777 and place “ALERTOC” into the body of the text message.

The Nixle platform is used on a general basis to inform the public of various incidents which include, but are not limited to, police activity that impacts a neighborhood, accidents which impact traffic flow, road closures, or general notifications that the city has deemed important enough for the public to be notified of quickly. To opt into the Nixle system, send a text message to 888777 and place Placentia’s ZIP Code – “92870” – in to the body of the text message.

With the implementation of these platforms, the systems are only effective with more people being enrolled into the systems. Additionally, the people that we encourage you to reach out to are the members of the community that are not familiar with signing-up for emergency alerts on a mobile device or are not technologically-proficient. By helping these members of our community sign-up for AlertOC and Nixle, the City of Placentia will be able to effectively reach the greatest number of people and potentially save the greatest amount of lives.

ADDRESSING HOMELESSNESS IN PLACENTIA

Based on the local mandate presided upon by U.S. District Judge David Carter, North Orange County cities (NOC cities) are required to work on a homeless housing plan for the region. The housing plan creates Navigation Centers that would provide comprehensive supportive services including job training, recreational services, mental health, transportation services and 200 beds to the homeless residents of the North Orange County region. Additionally, the City's ability to address homelessness has been further diminished based upon the *Martin v. Boise* (2018) ruling by the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals on September 2nd, 2018. The ruling asserted that the City of Boise's camping and disorderly conduct ordinance was unconstitutional, relying upon the U.S. Supreme Court precedent that it is cruel and unusual to criminalize a person's status, as opposed to his or her conduct. Ultimately, the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals ruled that these types of Ordinances violated the Eighth Amendment when enforced against those who have been forced to sleep outdoors because they cannot obtain shelter.

The City has thus far utilized a variety of tools to enforce the City's anti-camping laws while at the same time providing compassion to the homeless population. The City has established a Homeless Task Force comprised of Mayor Pro Tem Ward Smith, City Staff, HIS House, Cal Trans, BNSF, Department of Transportation and the California Highway Patrol. The Task Force meets bi-weekly and as a result has initiated enforcement and clean up along areas near the 57 freeway and rail road tracks. Despite these collaborative efforts, the homeless population continues to grow.

If cities do not comply with the mandate to add emergency housing, they will be susceptible to significant litigation. Cities will not legally be able to enforce their anti-camping ordinance to keep the homeless from creating an encampment in public areas, such as city halls, senior centers, parks and neighborhood sidewalks, including sidewalks in front of residents' very own homes.

PLACENTIA AND NORTH ORANGE COUNTY

In response to these Federal requirements and court decisions, and to ensure that the City maintains local control over enforcement of its own anti-camping ordinance in public areas, including public sidewalks, the City of Placentia along with the NOC cities have identified two potential locations for Navigation Centers – one in Placentia and one in Buena Park.

The proposed Placentia location will be determined by identifying a location that is suitable for safely housing persons that are experiencing homelessness as well as addressing the following factors:

- Siting for Industrial zone (meets SB2 zone criteria)
- Community feedback
- Property is available for purchase and can accommodate up to 100 beds per Federal lawsuit
- Proximity to residential areas
- Cost of construction, suitable security and operational plan, and well managed wraparound services.

In addition, the proposed Navigation Center purchase and upgrades will be fully funded by grants and is contingent upon receiving additional grant funding for construction improvements, operations and maintenance of the Navigation Center.

The management and operational plan for the Navigation Centers will specify certain requirements to ensure local control for providing safe and secure housing as well as providing comprehensive programs and services. The operational plan includes funding for two, full-time Police Officers to patrol the surrounding area including parks, neighborhoods, bus stops, etc. to ensure safety.

The Navigation Centers will be referral-only based facilities with controlled access in and out via transportation only. The proposed Navigation Centers will work not only to house the homeless, but to provide health resources, job and social skills, and opportunities to reunite with family and friends, with the goal of integrating North Orange County's homeless to become productive members of society while decreasing the number of homeless in public areas.

LEARN-TO-SWIM PROGRAM

The City of Placentia Learn-to-Swim Program offers swimming instruction for youth ages nine months through twelve years. All Water Safety Instructors are trained and certified by the American Red Cross. The program is offered at Valencia High School in the morning and afternoon and at El Dorado High School for evening classes.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Learn-to-Swim Program registration begins at the Summer Recreation Program Kick-off event on Saturday, May 18, at Placentia City Hall and is not available online. Only Placentia residents will be permitted to register on this day. A parent or legal guardian must be present to register a child. Proof of residency (i.e. driver's license, state issued ID card, or recent utility bill) must be provided to be eligible to register. Registration numbers will be handed out on a first-come, first-serve basis beginning at 7:00 a.m. Registration will begin at 9:00 a.m. and continues until 12:00 p.m. Proof of age is required at the time of registration for new program participants (birth certificate).

PUBLIC RECREATION SWIM

The City of Placentia offers free recreation swim at the Gomez Community Pool and at the Whitten Community Pool. Children seven years and under must be accompanied by an adult in a swimsuit and must be within arm's reach at all times. Flotation devices are NOT allowed during recreation swim.

SWIM LESSON DESCRIPTIONS

Big Fish, Lil' Fish

9 months to 3 years

A basic water orientation class for tots and their parents. The child and parent work on skills together in the water. Skills include water adjustment, blowing bubbles, kicking, holding onto the wall, floating on back, water entry and exit, face submergence, and safety skills. A parent is required to accompany each child.

Tiny Tots

3 to 5 years

A class for preschoolers who have very little to no aquatic experience. Fun and safety are emphasized while learning necessary swimming skills such as water entry and exit, face submergence, blowing bubbles, water adjustment, kicking, exploring arm movements, and safety skills.

Level 1

5 to 12 years

A class for children who have very little to no aquatic experience. Fun and safety are emphasized while learning necessary swimming skills: water entry and exit, face submergence, water adjustment, floating on front and back, retrieval of submerged objects, and safety skills. In this class children will learn how to side breathe as well as practice freestyle and backstroke.

Level 2

5 to 12 years

Class reviews entry by stepping or jumping from side, bobbing, head submergence and holding breath, floating on front and back, treading water, side breathing, freestyle, backstroke, and safety skills. Participants will also be introduced to elementary backstroke.

Prerequisite - Participant must be able to demonstrate the following with little to no assistance: safely enter and exit the water, float on front and back without support, swim freestyle the entire length of the pool.

Level 3

5 to 12 years

In this class, children will review side breathing techniques, freestyle, backstroke, and elementary backstroke. They will also be introduced to breaststroke and kneeling and standing dives. Participants will continue to practice treading water, retrieving submerged objects, and safety skills.

Prerequisite - Participants should be very comfortable in the water and able to swim a least one lap (25 yards) without any assistance.

Level 4

5 to 12 years

Class will continue to practice treading water, retrieving submerged objects, kneeling and standing dives, and safety skills. Along with perfecting freestyle, backstroke, and breaststroke, they will be introduced to butterfly.

Prerequisite - Participants should be very confident freestyle swimmers and comfortable with backstroke and breaststroke.


