The American Public Works Association has declared May 21-27, 2023 as National Public Works Week. NPWW is a celebration of the tens of thousands of men and women in North America who provide and maintain the infrastructure and services collectively known as Public Works. This year's theme is Connecting the World Through Public Works, which celebrates the vital contribution public works professionals make every day to communities all across North America, and it invites the public to celebrate their quiet dedication and indispensable influence on our way of life. Public works professionals include those who manage water, sewer, public transportation, and refuse removal systems as well as those responsible for maintaining public buildings and grounds. They are, in short, the people who maintain and improve the systems and services vital to our communities' health, safety and comfort.



## Do you know what to do in the event of a disaster?

Do you know how to prepare before a disaster occurs: If the answer to these questions is No, come join the Community Emergency Response Team (CERT). CERT Training is FREE and open to anyone interested in learning about how they can be an effective responder in their community. In this 20-hour curriculum approved by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), participants will learn how to:

- Identify and anticipate hazards in the community
- Reduce fire hazards in the home and workplace
- Extinguish small fires
- Assist emergency responders
- Set up medical treatment areas
- Provide disaster first aid
- Help reduce survivor stress

**REPUBLIC SERVICES** (trash company) offers residents a FREE bulky item pick-up service. They will remove old appliances and furniture at no cost to you! Southern California Edison is the agency to call if your street lights are out. You may report the lights out by calling (800) 655-4555. Prior to your call, it will be helpful to write down the street light pole number located at the base of the pole to identify the exact location.



## PLACENTIA FIRE & LIFE SAFETY DEPARTMENT POOL SAFETY TIPS

- Adult supervision should be provided at all times by a responsible, distraction-free adult. Do not read, use a cell phone, or leave children alone while near a pool.
- Pre-school aged children should be within arm's length.
- Install 4-sided fencing that separates the pool area from the home and yard. The fence should be at least 4 feet high and use self-closing, self-latching gates.
- Keep the pool deck clear of floats, balls, and toys after you get out of the pool.

## FREE USED OIL RECYCLING

Placentia residents are eligible for FREE recycling of their used engine, transmission and gear oil, plastic motor oil bottles, oil filters and oily rags from their homes. The household collection program is FREE via a grant from Cal Recycle. ## SB 1383 MANDATORY COMPLIANCE IS COMING TO PLACENTIA!

Beginning Summer 2023, Placentia residents will be able to divert food scraps from the trash bin as an effort to reduce the amount of organic waste sent to local landfills. Single-family residents will commingle food scraps with yard waste in the brown bin. Multi-family residents will obtain a designated receptacles for organics and recyclables. At this time, there are no change to current waste disposal for residents. (Hamer Island residents can already dispose of food scraps in the brown bin.) The City and Republic Services will be providing further information to residents once a Citywide Organics Recycling Programs is implemented. Organics recycling service is available to businesses. ## NEW PARKING LOT IN OLD TOWN PLACENTIA

The City recently completed construction of the newest public parking lot in Old Town Placentia. The Main Street Parking Lot is located at 321 S. Main Street, just south of Santa Fe Avenue. The formerly vacant lot was completely repaved with new asphalt and permanent parking stall striping. The parking lot has 62 new parking spaces, LED lighting, fencing, landscaping, and signage as well as new ADA-compliant accessible parking spaces. The new parking lot is located in the heart of Old Town and it is addition to several other nearby parking lots and on-street parking. The new public lot assists businesses in serving their customers, and the improved signage connects visitors to nearby parking lots. The City encourages visitors to check out and use the new lot when visiting Old Town Placentia.



# RIBBON CUTTING CEREMONY HELD FOR SANTA FE PARK

The City recently held a ribbon-cutting ceremony at Santa Fe Park to celebrate the grand re-opening of the newly renovated playground at 550 W. Santa Fe Avenue.

Santa Fe Park is the third park in the City to be upgraded and themed through the City's newly created Placentia Parks Initiative. In following, the Parks Initiative Plan, the Santa Fe Park playground highlights a railroad theme. The playground features a custom 5-12 year old train engine play structure, slides, an enclosed climbing spinner, a 2-5 year old train car play structure, four new shade sails for the park, and new rubberized surfacing with a railroad design. The City extends a sincere thank you to St. Jude Medical Center for providing \$75,000 in grant funding towards the purchase of the 2-5 year old play structure.

The City Council approved the Placentia Parks Initiative Plan on June 1, 2021, as a comprehensive master list of park and building projects. Projects were prioritized by safety, age of equipment, and funding sources. City park renovation projects are funded through State Grants, Development Impact Fees, or Measure U funding.

Through this Initiative, the City is investing \$6.2 million into City parks and facilities, making it the largest investment in the last 25 years for Placentia parks and facilities. The City will also be creating a parks and public facilities master brochure for residents to identify each park and the amenities it has available. In addition, through the Placentia Parks Initiative, parks will also have new amenities such as picnic tables, barbecues, benches, water fountains, and trash/recycling receptacles for residents to enjoy.



# PLACENTIA'S "EXPAND THE FOREST" PROGRAM



The City of Placentia is still accepting applications for its Expand the Forest Program! This program, adopted as part of the City's Urban Forest Management Program, allows residents to purchase and dedicate a tree to commemorate a loved one or special event. Planting a tree in a City Park is a special way to honor a loved one and provides a gift to the whole community by contributing to the expansion of the City's Urban Forest. A dedication tree can be planted in a City Park, and potential tree sponsors can use a Park map to identify their preferred park and planting location(s). The cost to purchase and plant a tree will be funded by the tree

sponsor and is based on the current contract price paid by the City for 24-inch box trees. The current cost is \$300 for an Expand the Forest tree. Once a location is selected, and payment for the tree has been received, the City will arrange to have the tree planted by the City's landscape maintenance contractor, with or without the sponsor(s) in attendance, depending on their preference. Once planted, the City will assume maintenance responsibilities to care for the tree. The tree sponsor(s) will receive a certificate signed by the Mayor in appreciation of their tree sponsorship and be acknowledged in the City's quarterly Palm Newsletter.

# 2023 SUMMER AQUATICS

## LEARN-TO-SWIM PROGRAM

The City of Placentia Learn-to-Swim Program offers swimming instruction for youth ages nine months through twelve years. All Water Safety Instructors are trained and certified by the American Red Cross. The program is offered at Valencia High School in the morning and afternoon and at El Dorado High School for evening classes.

### BIG FISH, LIL' FISH

**9 MONTHS TO 3 YEARS**

A basic water orientation class for tots and their parents. The child and parent work on skills together in the water. Skills include water adjustment, blowing bubbles, kicking, holding onto the wall, floating on back, water entry and exit, face submergence, and safety skills. A parent is required to accompany each child.

### TINY TOTS

**3 TO 5 YEARS**

A class for preschoolers who have very little to no aquatic experience. Fun and safety are emphasized while learning necessary swimming skills such as water entry and exit, face submergence, blowing bubbles, water adjustment, kicking, exploring arm movements, and safety skills.

### LEVEL 1

**5 TO 12 YEARS**

A class for children who have very little to no aquatic experience. Fun and safety are emphasized while learning necessary swimming skills: water entry and exit, face submergence, water adjustment, floating on front and back, retrieval of submerged objects, and safety skills. In this class children will learn how to side breathe as well as practice freestyle and backstroke.

### LEVEL 2

**5 TO 12 YEARS**

Class reviews entry by stepping or jumping from side, bobbing, head submergence and holding breath, floating on front and back, treading water, side breathing, freestyle, backstroke, and safety skills. Participants will also be introduced to elementary backstroke.

*Prerequisite* - Participant must be able to demonstrate the following with little to no assistance: safely enter and exit the water, float on front and back without support, swim freestyle the entire length of the pool.

### LEVEL 3

**5 TO 12 YEARS**

In this class, children will review side breathing techniques, freestyle, backstroke, and elementary backstroke. They will also be introduced to breaststroke and kneeling and standing dives. Participants will continue to practice treading water, retrieving submerged objects, and safety skills.

*Prerequisite* – Participants should be very comfortable in the water and able to swim a least one lap (25 yards) without any assistance.

## REFUND REQUESTS

Refund requests for Learn-to-Swim classes must be made 7 days prior to the start of the session. A \$5 administration fee applies per class. Refund requests received less than 7 days prior to the start of the session will be processed at 50% of the registration fees. Refunds are not available once the session begins. There are no make-ups for missed classes or partial refunds.

We reserve the right to move your child from the class that you signed up for to one that is more developmentally appropriate.

## FREE PUBLIC RECREATION SWIM

The City of Placentia offers **FREE** public recreation swim at the Gomez Community Pool and at the Whitten Community Pool. Children seven years and under must be accompanied by an adult in a swimsuit and must be within arm's reach at all times.

**FLOTATION DEVICES ARE NOT ALLOWED DURING RECREATION SWIM.**




