PLACENTIA RECEIVES SIGNIFICANT CREDIT RATING INCREASE

The City is excited to announce Standard & Poor's (S&P) Global Ratings has raised its credit issuer rating from 'AA-' to 'AA.' S&P is a leading provider of transparent and independent credit ratings worldwide. The City also received a 'AA-' bond rating for a specific bond being issued for the future Public Safety Building. The City's issuer credit has been raised five notches in the past three years and has since gone from "junk status" credit to now AA, in the highest tier of issuer credit.

The upgraded credit rating will have several positive implications for the City of Placentia. It will enhance the City's ability to secure financing at favorable interest rates, lowering borrowing costs and potentially saving taxpayers money. Additionally, the improved rating will attract more investors and businesses to Placentia, creating opportunities for economic development and job growth.

The City's S&P issuer credit rating is a forward-looking opinion about its overall creditworthiness and focuses on the City's capacity and willingness to meet its financial commitments. The improved rating can be attributed to the City's strong financial management and prudent fiscal policies, positioning Placentia as an attractive destination for investors and fostering continued economic growth.

SB 1383 IS COMING TO PLACENTIA IN 2024!

SB 1383, also known as Senate Bill 1383: Short-Lived Climate Pollutants reduction strategy, was passed by California legislature to reduce methane emissions and space in local landfills. Everyone will be required to separate organic waste (e.g. food scraps, food-soiled paper, green waste, cardboard and other paper products). FIRE AND LIFE SAFETY RELEASES 2021-2023 BIENNIAL REPORT HIGHLIGHTING REDUCED RESPONSE TIMES

The City recently released the Fire and Life Safety Department July 2021 – June 2023 Biennial Report. This comprehensive report highlights the Department's dedication to protecting the Placentia community and showcases achievements, training efforts, and goals for future growth and success.

The Report provides information on the Department's efforts in fire prevention, emergency response, and community outreach. It also includes detailed statistics on response times, incident types, and the varied fire and EMS calls personnel are dispatched within the City. More specifically, the report indicates that the Department had 2,564 fire calls from July 2021 to June 2023, and the average response time was 6 minutes and 21 seconds.

In addition to the accomplishments of the Placentia Fire and Life Safety Department, the report also highlights the City's EMS improvements with Lynch EMS, the City's 911 paramedic services provider.

As the holidays approach, we would like to remind you that the Placentia Police Department has established a Safe Exchange Zone. We know that Craigslist, Offer Up and other exchange site transactions can sometimes go badly.

To provide the public with a safer environment to do business, the Police Department has designated the front entrance to the police station as a Safe Exchange Zone. The area is well lit, under 24-hour video surveillance, and is clearly marked with signage. This area may be used by the public to conduct child custody exchanges, private property, and E-Commerce transactions, such as Craigslist, Offer Up and others.

This Safe Exchange Zone should help deter potential scammers and other criminal activities associated with on-line purchasing activities, as well as help make child custody exchanges less challenging.

The design is approved by the property manager/landlord, and then the SiFi team will apply for the proper permits. Once they obtain the necessary permits, the construction process will begin with a minimally invasive process where they use a micro trenching machine in the roadway to lay conduit in a shallow trench. CHRISTMAS TREE RECYCLING

Every year, more than 40,000 tons of Christmas trees require handling at the end of the season in California. You can help divert waste from the landfill by following these simple steps:

1. Remove the tree stand (wood or metal), decorations and tinsel from your tree.
2. Cut up your tree and place in your brown container (no tree stands please). The pieces should fit easily in your container.
3. Place the brown container at the curb along with the other containers on your regular collection day.

If you are unable to put your tree in your brown yard waste can, place the tree at the curb next to your containers on your regular collection day Tuesday, December 26, 2023 until Friday, January 12, 2024. Trees are collected in a special truck. Trees larger than six-feet must be cut into four-foot lengths. Flocked trees can not be recycled, please call (714) 238-3300 to schedule a pickup.

PLACENTIA'S "EXPAND THE FOREST" PROGRAM

The City of Placentia is still accepting applications for its Expand the Forest Program! This program, adopted as part of the City's Urban Forest Management Program, allows residents to purchase and dedicate a tree to commemorate a loved one or special event. Planting a tree in a City Park is a special way to honor a loved one and provides a gift to the whole community by contributing to the expansion of the City's Urban Forest. A dedication tree can be planted in a City Park, and potential tree sponsors can use a Park map to identify their preferred park and planting location(s). The cost to purchase and plant a tree will be funded by the tree

sponsor and is based on the current contract price paid by the City for 24-inch box trees. The current cost is \$390 for an Expand the Forest tree. Once a location is selected, and payment for the tree has been received, the City will arrange to have the tree planted by the City's landscape maintenance contractor, with or without the sponsor(s) in attendance, depending on their preference. Once planted, the City will assume maintenance responsibilities to care for the tree. The tree sponsor(s) will receive a certificate signed by the Mayor in appreciation of their tree sponsorship and be acknowledged in the City's quarterly Palm Newsletter.


