Through this user-friendly app, residents can report issues within the city, such as graffiti, potholes, dead animals on the road, and more. Residents can also access the latest news, apply for jobs, renew business licenses, and much more. The iPlacentia app serves as a centralized hub for all things Placentia, empowering users to engage with city services efficiently.

For those who prefer traditional means of communication, the City website, www.placentia.org, provides a wealth of information and resources. Residents can explore city services, access important documents, and stay up-to-date with the latest developments within the community. The website serves as a valuable resource for individuals seeking information about Placentia's offerings and initiatives.

PARQUE DE LOS NINOS PLAYGROUND RIBBON CUTTING

The City recently held a ribbon cutting ceremony to unveil the newest park playground renovation project at Parque de los Ninos. The renovation project is part of the Placentia Parks Initiative and included removal and replacement of the existing playground structure and new park amenities. In following the City's goal to create "destination parks," the new playground features a colorful dinosaur theme, complete with a rope spinner, new slides, incorporated shade, tower play structure, swings, and a T-Rex climber.

Funding for the renovation project is part of the City's Capital Improvement Program budget and includes Measure U Funds and Grant Funds from the California Parks and Recreation Society/GameTime. For more information on park projects, contact the Community Services Department at (714) 993-8232.

RIBBON CUTTING CEREMONY HELD FOR SANTA ANGELINA AFFORDABLE SENIOR LIVING COMMUNITY

In partnership with National CORE, the City of Placentia celebrated a ribbon cutting for a new 65-unit affordable senior living apartment community called "Santa Angelina," located on property owned and operated by the Church of the Blessed Sacrament located at 1314 N. Angelina Ave. in Placentia.

In partnership with the church, National CORE – which developed and will now operate the senior housing development – spearheaded the transformation of the church campus into two, two-story residential buildings providing age-restricted rental housing for individuals 62 years of age or older who earn less than 60% of the area median income. Twenty-one apartment homes are reserved as permanent supportive housing for unhoused seniors or those at risk of becoming unhoused.

Residents of Santa Angelina will belong to an engaged, service-enriched village linked to the adjacent church and surrounding community through a network of paseos, plazas, and courtyards. In addition, a new 1,500-square-foot community center will serve as a hub for events, supportive services, and programs. Other amenities include laundry facilities and outdoor recreation space.

Santa Angelina was one of the first communities in the state to receive California Housing Accelerator Funding. Launched in 2021 by the California Department of Housing and Community Development, the California Housing Accelerator is meant to fast-track affordable housing developments that have been stalled by the cap on state tax credits and bonds.

UPDATE ON SB 1383 ORGANICS RECYCLING PROGRAM

The City of Placentia, along with every city in the state of California, is required by State law to implement enforcement compliance with both recycling and organic waste recycling programs. California Senate Bill 1383 (SB 1383) requires reductions of organic waste in landfills as part of a greater plan to reduce emissions of short-lived climate pollutants.

Organic waste includes food waste such as vegetables, fruits, cooked meat scraps, dairy, bread, pasta, rice, grains, eggshells, coffee grounds, tea bags, plate scraps, food-soiled paper (i.e., used pizza boxes), and yard waste such as tree trimmings, grass clippings and leaves, and nonhazardous wood waste. SB 1383 established targets to achieve a 50% reduction in statewide disposal of organic waste from the 2014 level by 2020 and a 75% reduction by 2025.

The City continues to negotiate with Republic Services on a new Citywide Organics Recycling Program to meet the requirements of SB 1383. The City and Republic Services will provide further information to residents once a program has been approved. Currently, there is no change to the current bins and waste disposal process for Placentia single-family residents. Former Hamer Island residents are the exception, since their organics recycling program started in July 2023.

FALL SHREDDING & E-WASTE RECYCLING EVENT

The City invites Placentia residents and businesses to participate in a free community Shredding & E-Waste Recycling Event on Saturday, October 26, 2024, from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm at the Placentia Civic Center, 401 East Chapman Avenue. Shredding documents can help prevent fraud and identity theft. Placentia residents and businesses are invited to have their confidential documents destroyed on-site and dispose of old electronics for free.

A maximum of six (6) banker box size containers will be accepted from each household or business location in Placentia. Please place items in the trunk for easy access and ensure your containers are free from metals or debris that can damage the shredding equipment. If the documents are in a 3-ring binder, please remove it before shredding. Paper clips, staples, rubber bands and file folders are acceptable. Most electronics that plug into an outlet and any items with a screen will be accepted for free, but there will be a fee for major household appliances. The service charges for major appliances are:

- \$10 - Microwaves, Cooling Units (*Water Dispensers, Air Conditioners*), Personal Refrigerators (*wine coolers, mini freezers*)
- \$20 - Water Heaters, Freezers
- \$30 - Washing Machines, Dryers, Dishwashers, Stoves, etc.
- \$40 - Refrigerators (Standard 2-3 doors).
- Automotive batteries and rechargeable tools and electronics batteries will also be accepted, but smaller household batteries will not.

No household hazardous waste such as chemicals, paint or unused medication will be accepted. To dispose of hazardous waste, please visit the nearest Orange County Hazardous Waste Collection Center. CERT TRAINING: THE CITY OF PLACENTIA'S APPROACH TO WHOLE COMMUNITY DISASTER PREPAREDNESS

Throughout the State of California, many people have seen the catastrophic levels of devastation that often occur from large-scale wildfires, earthquakes, and other natural and human-induced disasters. The immediate confusion and destruction that typically occurs from these events initially overwhelms the local first responders, but the shining light that is found in these incidents is from the large number of volunteers that arrive to help their fellow neighbors and community.

When large-scale emergencies occur throughout the nation, we often find that the non-traditional first responders are neighbors helping neighbors; therefore, it is the mission of the City of Placentia's office to provide consistent training and resources to the members of our community to ensure that in an emergency, our neighborhoods and communities can quickly recover from a disaster. In Emergency Management, many officials term this act of kindness and self-sustainability as the Whole Community Approach to disasters, and in Placentia we believe the Whole Community Approach is critical to our city's resilience.

To ensure that our residents are ready for a large-scale emergency, the city offers CERT training to develop a city-wide group of volunteers that are trained and willing to respond to large-scale emergencies in their neighborhoods, throughout the city and throughout Orange County. Trained members of CERT often assist their neighbors and community in many ways and each person truly provides an invaluable level of support during large events and emergencies.

To sustain and increase our level of preparedness, free CERT courses are offered several times a year. The CERT course provides training in the areas of fire suppression, terrorism, search and rescue, disaster medical operations, and disaster psychology. Upon completion of CERT training, each participant will be given the option and resources to further their individual training to serve their neighbors and neighborhoods.

FIRE PREVENTION WEEK 2024 OCTOBER 6-12, 2024

This year's campaign, "Smoke alarms: Make them work for you!" strives to educate everyone about the importance of having working smoke alarms in the home.

Smoke alarms are a key component of fire prevention, alerting occupants within seconds of a fire. Fire prevention education is important for all members of the community, and we invite you to join us this October during Fire Prevention Week to learn more about how you can stay safe in case of a fire.

SMOKE ALARM KEY SAFETY TIPS:

- Install one in every bedroom, outside each separate sleeping area (hallways) and on each level of the home.
- Test by pushing the "test" button at least once a month to ensure the alarm is working properly.
- Replace smoke alarms when they are 10 years old or when any alarm doesn't respond when tested.



BREAST CANCER AWARENESS PATCHES

During the month of October, the Placentia Police Department is proud to support breast cancer awareness by helping raise funds for cancer research. 



THE PLACENTIA MILITARY BANNER RECOGNITION PROGRAM

The Placentia Military Banner Recognition Program is accepting applications for the 2024 installation through October 21st. The program, known as Placentia "Hometown Heroes," honors and recognizes Placentia residents currently serving as active-duty or honorably discharged veterans in the United States Armed Forces.

Branches of service include Air Force, Army, Coast Guard, Marines, National Guard, Navy, and Space Force. Honorees must have a current place of residence in Placentia or have an immediate family member (parent, spouse, son, daughter, grandparents) residing in Placentia. The banner will be installed along Kraemer Boulevard and Yorba Linda Boulevard based on the City's discretion and will remain on display for two years.

The City will not be responsible for replacing banners that are stolen, damaged, or destroyed due to sun, weather, vandalism, or any act of nature beyond our control, such as high winds. Upon the end of the display period, the banner will be given to the person named on the banner application. The banners are to be installed during the month of November. The cost to display each customized banner is \$260, and each service person is allowed one banner.

NATIONAL PRESCRIPTION DRUG TAKE BACK DAY

The Placentia Police Department is pleased to be participating in the National Prescription Drug Take Back Day on Saturday, October 26th. This is a drive thru event in the parking lot of the Civic Center between the hours of 10:00 am and 1:00 pm. The DEA and its partners will collect tablets, capsules, patches, and other solid forms of prescription drugs.

Drug Take Back Day offers free and anonymous disposal of unneeded medications. Collection sites will not accept illicit drugs. Liquid products, such as cough syrup, should remain sealed in their original container. The cap must be tightly sealed to prevent leakage. Unused prescription drugs thrown in the trash can be retrieved and abused or illegally sold. Unused drugs that are flushed contaminate the water supply. Take-back programs are the best way to dispose of old drugs.

If you cannot make it to the Drug Take Back event, take the meds out of their bottles, crush and mix them with something unappealing like used cat litter or coffee grounds, seal them in a bag or disposable container and throw that away.

PLACENTIA'S "EXPAND THE FOREST" PROGRAM



The City of Placentia is still accepting applications for its Expand the Forest Program! This program, adopted as part of the City's Urban Forest Management Program, allows residents to purchase and dedicate a tree to commemorate a loved one or special event. Planting a tree in a City Park is a special way to honor a loved one and provides a gift to the whole community by contributing to the expansion of the City's Urban Forest. A dedication tree can be planted in a City Park, and potential tree sponsors can use a Park map to identify their preferred park and planting location(s).

The cost to purchase and plant a tree will be funded by the tree sponsor and is based on the current contract price paid by the City for 24-inch box trees. The current cost is \$390 for an Expand the Forest tree. Once a location is selected, and payment for the tree has been received, the City will arrange

to have the tree planted by the City's landscape maintenance contractor, with or without the sponsor(s) in attendance, depending on their preference. Once planted, the City will assume maintenance responsibilities to care for the tree. The tree sponsor(s) will receive a certificate signed by the Mayor in appreciation of their tree sponsorship and be acknowledged in the City's quarterly Palm Newsletter.




