

# Placentia Veterans Registration

The Placentia Veterans Committee established a monument to honor local veterans. All veterans or families of active-duty service personnel who wish to have a name considered for placement on the monument must complete and submit this form by September 1. Each year, new names are placed on the monument before the Veterans Day Observance Program on November 11.

**Those with names on the monument include military service veterans and active-duty service personnel who were raised, educated, or entered the service in Placentia, including those who listed Placentia as their hometown when enlisting. Additionally, Placentia residents who have lived in the city for twenty-five years (25) or more and currently serve or previously served in the armed forces are eligible. All monument honorees must have been honorably discharged. Please print legibly.**
